



## Diving deep into the Magellanic Reef

Deep within the Large Magellanic Cloud (LMC) lies the 'Cosmic Reef', which is part of a larger star-forming region within the LMC. The larger nebula here is NGC 2014, an emission nebula with the open cluster Henize 57A at its heart. To the left of NGC 2014 is the blue nebulosity of NGC 2020. Jan Scheers shot this Hubble palette (SHO) image using a Planewave CDK24 telescope and an FLI PL9000 CCD camera, part of the equipment available from Telescope Live at the El Sauce Observatory, Chile. 190 minutes of H-alpha, O-III and S-II data was captured in 600-second sub-frames.
